

- Students receive a fictional occupation, salary, spouse, children, student loan and credit card debt, and medical insurance payments.
- Equipped with their new income and responsibilities, students visit various merchant tables to "purchase" housing, food, transportation, clothing, day care, and other necessities from pushy salespeople.
- A "Fickle Finger of Fate," giving students unexpected "expenses" or "windfalls," just like in real life.
- Students who make poor choices and run out of money can visit the credit union table to sort out expenses and create a budget.

After completing Bite of Reality, students report a greater understanding of the importance of saving money, developing wise spending habits, living within their means, and planning for the future.

- To host a Bite of Reality session, you will need a group of students (50-200), a large classroom, cafeteria, or gymnasium, 15-20 adults to play merchant and student support roles, and about two hours of class time.
